- -85° to 15° tilt mechanism
- 180° pan from mounting plate
- 180° swivel from centre arm joint

- This product is design for indoor use only. The bracket must be inspected at least every two months for loose joints or aged parts.



For this installation you will also require a Philips (cross) screw driver.









STEP 1 – Assemble and fit the desk clamp




STEP 2 – Assemble and install the extension arms
