Safety Instructions:

Caution: To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not remove the top cover. No user-serviceable parts inside. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel only.

Caution: Remember excessive loud noise can seriously damage long-term hearing, always keep volumes as low as possible.

- To avoid condensation forming inside, allow the unit to adapt to the surrounding temperatures when bringing it into a warm room after transport.
- This unit is for indoor use only.
- Don't place metal objects or spill liquid inside the unit. If a foreign object enters the unit, immediately disconnect the mains power.
- No naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, should be placed on the appliance.
- Keep the unit away from children.
- Inexperienced persons should not operate this device.
- Maximum safe ambient operating temperature is 40 degrees. Don't use this unit at higher ambient temperatures.
- Always unplug the unit when it is not used for a long time or before you start servicing.
- The power supply should always be in perfect condition. Switch the unit immediately off when the power supply cable is squashed or damaged, or there is any damage to the power supply casing.

Functions

- 1. USB 5 volt power supply input.
- 2. Output to balanced microphone input on a mixer.
- 3. Microphone Input.
- 4. Power indicator.
- 5. On off switch.

Operation

- Check the specification of your microphone is suitable for 48 volt phantom power.
- Plug a suitable microphone in to the microphone input socket.
- Connect the output to a microphone input on a mixer.
- Make sure all volumes are turned down.
- Plug the phantom powers power supply into a suitable USB socket and switch on.
- Check the power light comes on.
- Gradually turn up the mixer volumes.
